Jeppesen NavData for cycles 1208 and 1209, effective 26 July 2012 and 23 August 2012 respectively, contain an incorrect missed approach hold on the VOR DME-A [VDMA] at St Thomas Muni; St Thomas, Ontario, Canada (CYQS).

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE MISSED APPROACH HOLD FOR THE VOR DME-A [VDMA] IN CYCLES 1208 AND 1209 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1210, effective 20 September 2012. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 31 AUG 12 and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site:
