Outdated Procedure Coding

Jeppesen NavData for cycles 1305 and 1306, effective 02 May and 30 May 2013 respectively, contains outdated procedure coding. Jeppesen did not receive updated source information from the US DOD for Farah, Afghanistan (OAFR). As a result, changes to procedures listed below could not be processed for cycle 1305 and cycle 1306 NavData.

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE PROCEDURES LISTED BELOW IN NAVDATA CYCLES 1305 AND 1306.

PLEVU ONE RNAV DEPARTURE	[PLEVU1]
RNAV (GPS) RWY 15	[R15]
RNAV (GPS) RWY 33	[R33]

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1307, effective 27 June 2013. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://ww1.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts.jsp?region=MiddleEast>).
