Incorrect Missed Approach Altitude

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1012, effective 18 November 2010, contains incorrect Missed Approach Altitude for the NDB-A [NDBA] procedure at Campbell River Airport; Campbell River, BC (CYBL). The correct Missed Approach Altitude is 5300' to QQ NDB.

THEREFORE, USE EXTREME CAUTION WHEN USING THE NDB-A [NDBA] MISSED APPROACH AT CAMPBELL RIVER (CYBL) IN CYCLE 1012 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1013, effective 16 December 2010. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 26 November 09, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/alerts.jsp>).
