Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0903, effective 12 Mar 2009, contains incorrect Missed Approach Holding data for the VOR-A [VORA] procedure at Sherbrooke Airport; Sherbrooke, Quebec (CYCS).

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE VOR-A [VORA] MISSED APPROACH HOLDING PATTERN AT SHERBROOKE (CYSC) IN CYCLE 0903 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0904, effective 09 April 2009. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 20 March 09, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/alerts.jsp>).
