Airway Segments Cancelled

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1210 and 1211, effective 20 September 2012 and 18 October 2012 respectively, contains incorrect airway information. Per Colombia AIP Supplement A27/12-C46/12 airway UQ115 segments from Buvis (BUV) VOR/DME – XOGEN waypoint are cancelled.

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE UQ115 BETWEEN BUVIS (BUV) AND XOGEN IN CYCLE 1210 AND 1211 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1212, effective 15 NOV 2012. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 26 Oct 2012, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts>).
