Incorrect turn on RNAV Standard Instrument Departure (SID) procedures

Jeppesen NavData for cycles 1209 and 1210, effective 23 August 2012 and 20 September 2012 respectively, contains an incorrect coding for RNAV SIDs MIADA 3G [MIAD3G], MUVLA 1G [MUVL1G] and SITAT 1G [SITA1G] at Dubai Intl; Dubai, UAE (OMDB).

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE RNAV SIDs MIADA 3G [MIAD3G], MUVLA 1G [MUVL1G] and SITAT 1G [SITA1G] IN CYCLES 1209 AND 1210 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1211, effective 18 October 2012. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site:
