SETN Tachina, Ecuador late Supplement 0913

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1305, effective 02 May 2013, contains incorrect coding at Tachina, Ecuador; General Rivadeneira (SETN) airport. Ecuador AIP Supplement 09, Effective 22 April 2013, was received after the date specified by ICAO for aeronautical information distribution. As a result, changes to the Approach 6 NDB ILS DME Rwy 18 [I18-6] approach could not be processed for the 22 April 2013 effective date.

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE APPROACH 6 NDB ILS DME RWY 18 [I18-6] IN CYCLE 1305 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1306, effective 30 May 2013. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 24 May 2013, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts>).
