Procedure Unusable

Jeppesen NavData for cycles 1212 and 1213, effective 15 Nov 2012 and 13 Dec 2012 respectively, contains an approach transition turn altitude not captured on NDB DME RWY 11, [Q11] at Ezeiza Intl Ministro Pistarini; Buenos Aires, Argentina (SAEZ).

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE NDB DME RWY 11 [Q11] IN CYCLES 1212 AND 1213.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1301, effective 10 Jan 2013. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 07 Dec 2012, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts>).
