Outdated Approach Procedure Coding

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1111, effective 20 October 2011, contains outdated Instrument Approach Procedure coding for Maun Airport; Maun, Botswana (FBMN). Botswana AIP Supplements 032/11, 033/11 and 034/11 contain important changes effective 31 OCT 11 (non-AIRAC date). The data therein could not be processed for Navdata cycle 1111. Jeppesen Navdata for cycle 1112 will not contain approach procedure information for Maun Airport (FBMN).

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE FOLLOWING APPROACH PROCEDURES IN CYCLE 1111 NAVDATA:

RNAV (GNSS) RWY 08 [R08]
RNAV (GNSS) RWY 26 [R26]
VOR DME RWY 08 [D08]
VOR DME RWY 26 [D26]
NDB RWY 26 [N26]

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1113, effective 15 December 2011. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 11 NOV 11, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site
