Incorrect Arrival, Departure and Approach procedures in NavData Cycle 1213

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1213, effective 13 Dec 2012, contains incorrect Arrival, Departure and Approach procedure coding for Irkutsk, Russia (UIII).

RUSSIAN NOTAMs A4807/12 and A4812/12, issued on 29 Nov 2012, have **cancelled all changes** contained in AIRAC AIP AMDT 12/12 and 13/12 respectively, for Irkutsk (UIII).

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE UIII ARRIVAL, DEPARTURE OR APPROACH PROCEDURES IN CYCLE 1213.

Correct coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1301, effective 10 Jan 2013. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://ww1.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts.jsp?region=Eastern%20Europe>).
