Procedures Affected During Outage of TOE VOR Extended

The Jeppesen NavData approach, arrival, and departure procedures for cycle 1202, Effective 8 February 2012, at Matsumoto, Japan – Matsumoto Airport (RJAF), Noto, Japan – Noto Airport (RJNW), and Toyama, Japan – Toyama Airport (RJNT) are unusable until 1230 UTC 7 MAR 2012. Per Japan NOTAM's C0059/12 and C0060/12 the unserviceability of the Toyama VOR/DME (TOE) has been extended until 1230 UTC on 7 MAR 2012.

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE SID/STAR/APPROACH PROCEDURES LISTED BELOW IN CYCLE 1202 NAVDATA.
