Incorrect Class D Boundary

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1305, effective 02 May 2013, contains incorrect airspace data at Crystal (KMIC) Minneapolis MN. The correct Class D Boundary should be a circle extended laterally 3.8NM centered at Crystal (KMIC) with vertical limits GND – 3400' MSL, excluding that airspace within the Minneapolis Class B.

THEREFORE, USE CAUTION IN VICINITY OF CRYSTAL (KMIC) AIRPORT WHEN USING NAV DATA IN CYCLE 1305.
