Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1212, effective 15 November 2012, contains an incorrect Arrival Identifier for the Concord One [CCR1] at Sacramento Intl; Sacramento, California (KSMF). The Arrival has been revised and upnumbered to Concord Two [CCR2] Arrival.

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE CONCORD ONE [CCR1] ARRIVAL IN CYCLE 1212 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1213, effective 13 December 2012. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 09 NOV 12, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www1.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts.jsp?region=UnitedStates>).
