***Suspension of Standard Instrument Departures (SIDs) and Standard Instrument Arrivals (STARs)***

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0809, effective 28 August 2008, contains incorrect SID and STAR information for Eleftherios Venizelos International Airport, Athens, Greece (LGAV) due to the postponement of AIRAC AMDT 04/2008, which was effective 28 August 2008. The Amendment has been postponed until NavData Cycle 0810, effective 25 September 2008, by NOTAM CL IA 1714/08, dated 22 August 2008. As a result of the late postponement, Jeppesen was unable to process the updates.

**THEREFORE, DO NOT USE STANDARD INSTRUMENT DEPARTURE PROCEDURES (SIDs) FOR ELEFThERIOS VENIZELOS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IN CYCLE 0809 NAVDATA.**

**STANDARD INSTRUMENT ARRIVALS (STARs) CAN BE USED WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE PROCEDURES LISTED BELOW:**

ABLON 1P [ABLO1P]	BADEL 3P [BADE3P]	XORKI 1P [XORK1P]
XORKI 2B [XORK2B]		

The data currently contained in Jeppesen's NavData will become effective in cycle 0810, effective date 25 September 2008, unless the source provider further defers the implementation. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning with the 5 SEP 08 revision, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site ([www.jeppesen.com](http://www.jeppesen.com), click on Aviation Resources, Online Publications, NavData Alerts and Notices). The Jeppesen charts will be enhanced by yellow charts (10-2F to 10-2L and 10-3X5 to 10-3X26) in the 5 SEP 08 revision. Yellow charts will be posted on HubWatch as soon as they are available ([www.jeppesen.com](http://www.jeppesen.com), click on Notices and Alerts, then HubWatch on the left hand side).
