Incorrect Missed Approach coding for Approach Procedure ILS Rwy 35 [I35C]

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1207, effective 28 Jun 2012, contains incorrect Missed Approach coding for Approach Procedure ILS Rwy 35 [I35C].

Missed Approach **turn** shall start when passing D3.0 **OEG** instead of D3.0 GRZ.

THEREFORE, USE CAUTION WHEN FLYING THE MISSED APPROACH FOR ILS RWY 35 APPROACH [I35C] AT GRAZ, AUSTRIA (LOWG).

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1208, effective 26 Jul 2012. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 20 Jul 2012, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts>).
