



**Navigation Data Alert**

**Date: April 30, 2008**

**Subject: Intersection Data on Worldwide Datacard (Garmin AT p/n 138-0424) and International Datacard (Garmin AT p/n 138-0426)**

**Navigation Databases for the Following Product Families:**

- **Apollo 2001 Dzus**
- **Apollo 2101 C129**
- **Apollo GX50/55/60/65**

**All Databases beginning with cycle 0805 and later**

The number of intersections in the datacards listed above has increased to the point where it has become necessary to split an intersection category into two separate categories.

**Worldwide Datacard (Garmin AT p/n 138-0424)**

The number of intersections in the INT(E)UR category has increased beyond the ability to handle them as a single category. This category previously included intersections in Europe, Africa, and the Middle East. The Middle East intersections have been removed and placed in a new category labeled INT(M)ES.

**International Datacard (Garmin AT p/n 138-0426)**

The number of intersections in the INT(W) category has increased beyond the ability to handle them as a single category. This category previously included intersections in Europe, Africa, and the Middle East. The Middle East intersections have been removed and placed in a new category labeled INT(M).

This change has been incorporated into all database cycles beginning with cycle 0805 (May 8, 2008) and later. For pilots operating in the Middle East area you will need to search for intersections in the Middle East in the new category. The Middle East includes these countries: Afghanistan, Bahrain, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cyprus, India, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Maldives, Nepal, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Sri Lanka, Syria, Turkey, United Arab Emirates, and Yemen.
