Incorrect Altitude on Missed Approach

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0901, effective 15 January 2009, contains incorrect data for Del Norte Intl; Monterrey, Mexico (MMAN). The missed approach segment of the VOR DME Rwy 29 has an incorrect altitude at the MTY VOR. The correct altitude should be 5000'.

THEREFORE, EXERCISE CAUTION WHEN USING THE MISSED APPROACH PORTION OF THE VOR DME RWY 29 [D29] IN CYCLE 0901 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0902, effective 12 February 2009. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 30 JAN 09, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/alerts-region.jsp?®ion=Latin+America>).
