***SIDs Unusable; Incorrect Missed Approach Altitude***

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0909, effective 27 August 2009, contains SID and Terminal Approach Procedure information in accordance with AIP Supplements A21/09, A22/09, A23/09, A24/09, A25/09, A26/09, A28/09, and A30/09 for (Alajuela) Juan Santamaria International Airport; San Jose, Costa Rica (MROC). However, AIP Supplements A21/09, A22/09, A23/09, A24/09, A25/09, A26/09, A28/09, and A30/09 have been cancelled by NOTAM's A1194/09 and A1202/09. All SID information is unusable. In addition, the missed approach altitude for ILS DME Rwy 07 [I07] and VOR DME Rwy 07 [D07] is incorrect and should be 5000' at TIO D4.0 fix.

**THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE SID INFORMATION AND EXERCISE CAUTION WHEN USING THE ILS DME RWY 07 [I07] AND VOR DME RWY 07 [D07] AT MROC IN CYCLE 0909 NAVDATA.**

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0910, effective 24 September 2009. Until then this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts.jsp?region=Latin%20America>).
