THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE MISSED APPROACH DATA FOR TACAN RWY 30C [T30C] IN CYCLE 1210 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1211, effective 18 October 2012.
