Incorrect Procedure Identifier

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1303, effective 07 March 2013, contains an incorrect procedure identifier for the Mazie One RNAV Arrival at Morristown Muni; Morristown, New Jersey (KMMU). The correct identifier is Mazie Two RNAV Arrival [MAZIE2].

THEREFORE, EXERCISE CAUTION WHEN SELECTING THE MAZIE RNAV ARRIVAL IN CYCLE 1303 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1304, effective 04 April 2013. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 08 MAR 13, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www1.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts.region=UnitedStates>). Please refer to the Morristown, New Jersey (KMMU) 10-2A chart dated 01 MAR 13 (effective 07 MAR) for valid information.
