Incorrect Missed Approach Altitude

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1211, effective 18 Oct 2012, contains an incorrect missed approach altitude at Noi Bai Intl; Hanoi, Vietnam (VNVB). The correct missed approach altitude should be to climb on runway heading to 1480'.

THEREFORE, USE CAUTION WHEN USING THE ILS Z RWY 11R [I11RZ] MISSED APPROACH AT VNVB IN CYCLE 1211 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1212, effective 15 Nov 2012. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 9 Nov 2012, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts>).
