Incorrect Departure Idents / Fix idents

As a result of receiving the Chile AIP Supplement 02/08 after the NavData cutoff, Jeppesen was unable to process the changes contained in the Supplement. Therefore, Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0808, effective 31 July 2008, contains several incorrect departure names/ fix idents at Arturo Merino Benitez Intl (SCEL); Santiago, Chile. Do to VOR DME SNO 113.7 replaced by VOR DME DGO 112.3 the following departures where renumbered:

ANGOD 7 renumbered ANGOD 8
ESLAR 3 renumbered ESLAR 4
LEYDA 5 renumbered LEYDA 6 – Note: Fix SNO VOR changed to DGO VOR
LINER 5 renumbered LINER 6
MERIK 1 renumbered MERIK 2
NEBEG 6 renumbered NEBEG 7
SEKAN 1 renumbered SEKAN 2
SANEL 2 renumbered SANEL 3 – Note: Fix SNO VOR changed to DGO VOR
SUPRA 7 renumbered SUPRA 8
YESOS 5 renumbered YESOS 6

THEREFORE, USE CAUTION WHEN USING DEPARTURE PROCEDURES AT ARTURO MERINO BENITEZ INTL (SCEL); SANTIAGO, CHILE IN CYCLE 0808 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0809, effective 28 August 2008. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 15 Aug 2008, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (www.jeppesen.com, click on Aviation Resources, On-line Publications, NavData NOTAMs/Alerts). The current Jepp charts will also be revised in the 22 August 08 revision. Between now and the 22 Aug 08 revision, the corrected chart will be available via Jeppesen HubWatch (www.jeppesen.com, click on Notices and Alerts, then HubWatch on the left hand side).
