Incorrect Airway Information

Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1304, effective 04 April 2013, contains incorrect information for Airway W22. This airway is coded from Coca (COC) NDB, and the correct airway data should use Coca (COV) VOR as shown below:

W22(G): Coca (COV) VOR (S00 26.7 W076 59.7) – EROLI CRP 326°/ 146°, 44NM, FL60

THEREFORE, USE CAUTION WHEN USING AIRWAY W22 IN CYCLE 1304 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1305, effective 02 May 2013. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 12 APR 2013, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts>).
