Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0904, effective 9 April 2009, contains incorrect Standard Instrument Departure (SID) Identifiers for Matecana Airport, Pereira, Colombia (SKPE). Colombia AIP Supplements C06/09 and C07/09 were received after the date specified by ICAO for aeronautical information distribution. As a result, the changes contained therein could not be processed for the 9 April 2009 effective date. The changes included multiple SID Name/Identifiers listed below.

THEREFORE, EXERCISE CAUTION WHEN USING THE DEPARTURES LISTED BELOW IN CYCLE 0904 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0905, effective 7 May 2009. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning with the 17 APR 09 revision, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts.jsp?region=South%20America>). The Jeppesen charts for Pereira, Colombia (SKPE) 10-3 and 10-3A will also be updated with the revised information in the 17 APR 09 revision. These updated charts will be available for download via Jeppesen HubWatch (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/publications/hubwatch.jsp>) until the charts are issued in the 17 APR 09 revision.
