Procedures Unusable

Jeppesen receives much of its aeronautical information on U.S. Air Force (USAF) bases through Department of Defense publications that are released just prior to the effective date. The release schedule for those publications does not allow Jeppesen to update its database and charts in time for the effective date of new and changing information. Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0901, effective 15 January 2009 contains data for some USAF approach procedures that has not been updated for changes effective 15 January. **The following procedures are unusable:**
