New Procedures made Effective by Class I NOTAM D0712/09

Jeppesen NavData for cycles 0906 and 0907, effective 04 June and 02 July 2009, respectively, contain Arrival, Departure, and Approach Procedure information for Kuching Intl; Kuching, Malaysia (WBGG) in accordance with Malaysia AIP. However, Malaysia AIP Supplement 11/2009 revised all Arrival, Departure and Approach Procedures at Kuching Intl effective by trigger notam. Malaysia Class I notam D0712/09 has made this information effective on 17 Jun 09. Due to the unknown "off cycle" effective date associated with this Class I notam Jeppesen was unable to include these new procedures in NavData cycle 0906 or 0907.

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE DEPARTURES/ARRIVALS/APPROACH PROCEDURES AT KUCHING INTL (WBGG) IN CYCLE 0906 OR 0907 NAVDATA.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0908, effective 30 July 2009. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 26 Jun 2009, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site:
