Arrival, Departure and Approach Procedures Re-Instated

NOTAM F3325/12 issued on 31 AUG 12, extended effectiveness of AIP Supplement 05/12 until 27 Feb 2013. Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1210, effective 20 Sep 2012, may not contain Arrival, Departure and Approach coding for Jinjiang Airport; Quanzhou; PR of CHINA (ZSQZ).

THEREFORE USE CAUTION WHEN USING ARRIVAL DEPARTURE AND APPROACH PROCEDURES AT JINJIANG (ZSQZ) IN CYCLE 1210 NAVDATA.

Coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1211, effective 18 Oct 2012. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning 20 Sep 2012, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen Web site (<http://www.jeppesen.com/company/alerts/aviation-alerts>).

Charts will be re-instated with Rev 14 SEP 12, and are attached as PDF for immediate use.
