Jeppesen NavData for cycle 1305, effective 02 May 2013, contains incorrect FAS Datablock / Path Point data for RNAV (GPS) Rwy 35 [R35] at Salt Lake City Intl; Salt Lake City, Utah (KSLC). The data supplied by source provider is invalid and we are working with the source provider to correct the data.

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE LP LEVEL OF SERVICE FOR THE RNAV (GPS) RWY 35 IN CYCLE 1305 NAVDATA.

The FAS Datablock / Path Point record and LP level of service will be removed until new data is received starting in NavData cycle 1306 effective 30 May 2013.
