Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0713, effective 20 December 2007, contains VARI1E Arrival starting at ABRAM Compulsory Reporting Point. The correct starting point for VARI1E Arrival is VARIG Compulsory Reporting Point.

THEREFORE, DO NOT USE THE VARI1E ARRIVAL IN THE 0713 NAVDATA CYCLE.

Revised coding will appear in Jeppesen NavData for cycle 0801, effective 17 January 2008. Until then an entry will appear in the NavData Change Notices beginning with the 4 January 2008 revision, and this Alert will be posted on the Jeppesen web site (www.jeppesen.com, click on Aviation Resources, On-line Publications, NavData NOTAMs/Alerts). For valid information, please refer to the Tripoli, SPLAJ (HLLT) 10-2A chart dated 13 OCT 06, effective 26 October 2006.
